## ADVERTISING SPECIFICATIONS

**Software:** We accept IBM and MAC files from the following programs: QuarkXpress \* version 5, InDesign\* and Photoshop®. Illustrator® files are acceptable as long as it is saved as an EPS with the fonts outlined.

**Fonts:** All fonts must be provided for the files (i.e.: Postscript and True Type).

**Color:** All colors in the files must be process/CMYK.

**Images:** Digital photographs/continuous tone images should be 300 dpi and line art/illustrations should be 1200 dpi. No images from the web are acceptable as they are too low resolution. All images must be in a composite format (preferably a TIF or an EPS). Please do not apply LZW or JPEG compression to your images or send pre-separated files. You must embed all images in your file. You must send all RAW, EPS and TIFF files used in your document.

**Proofs:** You must include a finalized, high resolution proof at 100% of size for all submitted ads.

**PDF files:** Only high resolution PDF files produced with full version of Adobe Acrobat® - not Acrobat Writer® are accepted. Must be CMYK.

Compressed files: If you are emailing your advertisement, you must compress your files. All emailed files must be compressed smaller than 5MB and sent to publisher@codyandbeyond.com. If files are too large to email, contact your sales rep for FTP information.
